



Seesaw

From April 2020, South Yarra Primary School will be using a program called 'Seesaw', which is an online platform that aids in the delivery of Remote and Flexible Learning. This platform allows teachers and students to engage in teaching and learning remotely.

Seesaw will offer daily overview messages from year level teaching teams, as well as place for students to communicate with their teacher. Year level teaching teams will upload learning for the week ahead for students to complete. Seesaw also offers the opportunity for student work to be uploaded and for teachers to provide feedback on selected work pieces.

Seesaw does not own the content added to the online classroom and all student work is private between the teacher and student. Classroom teachers control what is shared and with whom, with no student work visible outside those who have access to it. Seesaw is fully compliant with the Australian Privacy Act.
