

SOUTH YARRA PRIMARY SCHOOL

STUDENT REFERENCE POLICY



Rationale:

The South Yarra Primary School student reference policy states the school's position with regard to providing personal and/or academic references and providing reports for students seeking transfers to non-government schools.

Aim:

South Yarra Primary School is committed to the provision of excellent teaching and learning practices that maximise the learning opportunities for students within the state's education system – the Department of Education and Training.

Implementation:

Given South Yarra Primary School's commitment to the provision of excellent education in government schools and supporting our local secondary schools, references cannot be provided for students:

- Seeking scholarships in non-government schools
- Seeking transfers to non-government schools
- Seeking to secure placement on waiting lists in non-government schools.

At the Principal's discretion, the provision of references for students may be considered for:

- Students exiting South Yarra Primary School, applying for entry to Government School SEAL programs on completion of Year 6
- Students who may need to seek enrolment in interstate or overseas schools.

Evaluation

This policy will be reviewed in 2023.
